for free credit monitoring, ID  
theft protection and other benefits  
from a legal settlement.**

According to records from The Regents of the University of California, which oversees UCLA, you are a Settlement Class Member in the *Adlouni v. UCLA Health Systems* lawsuit. This notice informs you of the settlement terms, your rights, and available settlement benefits.

**What is the lawsuit about?** The lawsuit alleges The Regents failed to prevent cyberattackers from accessing sensitive and personal information stored on UCLA Health's computer network (the "Incident"). It is disputed whether the cyberattackers accessed or removed sensitive and personal information on the network. The parties agreed to settle the lawsuit and provide free credit monitoring and insurance. Other benefits may be available to you. You will receive benefits only if the Court approves the settlement.

**What do I get from the settlement?** You are entitled to two-years of **free** credit monitoring, identity theft protection and an insurance package. In addition, if you incurred any costs for preventive measures to protect your personal information between July 17, 2015 and March 20, 2019, you can receive reimbursement up to \$5,000. The total awards for Preventive Measures claims will be no more than \$300,000, and your award will be reduced pro rata if total valid claims exceed that amount. Examples of costs include card cancellation fees, credit monitoring costs, identity protection costs, and costs to freeze your credit reports. In addition, if you suffered any unreimbursed losses associated with identity theft or unauthorized use of your personal information such as declined payment, overdraft, returned check and/or customer service fees, or any other losses, you can receive up to 100% reimbursement up to \$20,000, including up to \$90 for time you spent dealing with identity theft issues. The total awards for Unreimbursed Losses claims will not exceed \$2,000,000 (\$1,700,000 plus the balance of the \$300,000 Preventive Measures fund), and your award will be reduced pro rata if total valid claims exceed that amount. The Regents will also spend \$5.5 to \$7.5 million, to implement or expedite cybersecurity enhancements for the UCLA Health Network.

**How do I get settlement benefits?** To get two years of free credit monitoring, identity theft protection, and insurance, return the post card attached to this notice or sign up at the website. The deadline

to submit is **September 16, 2019**. To receive a cash reimbursement of any costs you incurred seeking to protect your personal information, you must submit a Preventive Measures Claim Form by **June 18, 2019**. To receive a cash reimbursement of any losses associated with unauthorized use of your personal information, you must submit an Unreimbursed Losses Claim Form by **June 18, 2021**. **Do I have to be included in the settlement?** No. You can exclude yourself by sending a letter to the Claims Administrator postmarked by **May 20, 2019**.

**How do I object to the settlement?** Send your written objections along with proof of membership in the Settlement Class to the Court and counsel for the parties postmarked by **May 20, 2019**. You may also enter an appearance through an attorney if you wish. Full details on excluding yourself or objecting are at the website.

**What if I do nothing?** You will be bound by all orders and the judgment, will give up your right to sue The Regents over the Incident, and will not receive a settlement award.

**How will the attorneys be paid?** Class Counsel, Jeff Westerman of Westerman Law Corp., will seek attorneys' fees and reimbursement of expenses on behalf of Class Counsel and Plaintiffs' Counsel in an amount not to exceed \$3,275,000 in fees and \$135,000 in expenses and service awards, subject to court approval. Plaintiffs will ask the court for service awards of \$1,500 for the lead plaintiff and \$750 for the other named plaintiffs. Payment of these fees and awards will not reduce your settlement benefits.

**When is the final approval hearing?** The hearing is scheduled for June 18, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., in Department 1 at the Los Angeles Superior Court, 312 N. Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012.
